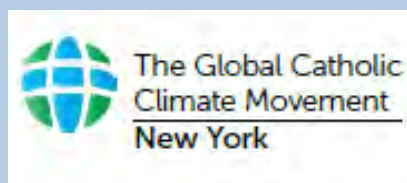
Sunday, July 24th Philadelphia
